

Diagnostic Imaging Checklist

Bronze

- If radiography is not available in the clinic there must be a clear written protocol for how to arrange radiography if required
- If radiography is available in the clinic, there must be:
 - A range of cassettes suitable for cats and kittens
 - A radiography machine with a light beam diaphragm
 - Sufficient provision for non-human restraint to allow radiography without manual restraint
 - Radiography records to include:
 - Patient details and area being radiographed
 - Details of exposure(s) and film(s), cassette(s) or other equipment used
 - Names of people present
- Silver Bronze criteria PLUS:
 - Ultrasound equipment must either be available at the clinic, or arrangements must be in place to have easy access to
 - ultrasound nearby when necessary
- **Gold** Silver criteria PLUS:
 - Radiography must be available in the clinic and meet all of the Bronze criteria
